High Concept



Hazzard Hollow Locals

Junior, a Degen Ape, and The Deuce, his Degen Panda friend, have started a bootleg, grassroots podcast. It is a combination of the Degen Universe and The Joe Rogan Experience, with a dash of the Dukes of Hazzard (tv show, not movie).

Each weekday a new animation is posted featuring Junior and The Deuce interviewing a cartoon guest. These can be either local residents of Hazzard Hollow or representatives of any partnering NFT project.

It is the creation of a new type of entertainment product, a grass roots Web3 cartoon show in short form, building to the larger brand awareness.

Junior and The Deuce run a lawn maintenance company, but they have dreams of turning their side hustle into their big break. The podcast that they run is shoestring, bootstrapped with their own gumption, and laughably cut-rate.

Each week, the boys interview a local resident of Hazzard Hollow in their attempt to leave behind their sweaty work life for a chance at being internet famous.

Reminiscent of shows like South Park and the Simpsons, Locals has a large cast of Hazzard Hollow residents who will visit the podcast and lend their personalities to this expansive world.

- Dorothy, Hazzard Hollow Tobacco Spit Champion
- Ultim8Bozz, the NFT and crypto-rich 12 y/o
- Pap, the grizzled old bear who writes the local Almanac

The characters will appear in a series of subsequent episodes as an introduction, and return to the show on various occasions.

Each of these characters will be offered as NFTs at auction on Exchange.art. In true web3 fashion, it allows the audience to own a portion of the show. Someone could be purchasing the next Cartman without realizing it.
